- an A4 printable image or photograph (300dpi JPG or TIF)
- a short animation (2mb 72dpi GIF)
- a short film (5mb AVI, MPG, MP4 or QUICKTIME file)

All work must be wholly original and must not exceed 10mb.

• Fine Art Category:

Size A3 (420mm x 297mm) either in portrait or landscape.

Recommended materials include acrylic paint, charcoal, dry or greasy pastels, water colour or collage on canvas or 180gsm art paper.
