SNAPSHOT OF PROJECTS REQUESTED AND/OR UNDERWAY

### GENERAL LIST

1. Identify and enhance village centres
2. Continue tree planting
3. Reinvigorate shopping strips – more landscaping, replace street furniture, upgrade pavements
4. Review parking permits and enforcement
5. Bundle overhead cables to reduce pruning and preserve our trees
6. Improve pedestrian safety
7. Broaden Parking Permit Policy
8. Increase pedestrian links between open spaces
9. Reduce impacts on residents of commercial garbage collection
10. Review entertainment venue operating hours
11. Introduce new community gardens
12. Landscape garden beds in traffic islands
13. Provide opportunities for volunteers to contribute to landscaping beyond existing Council programs

### AREA SPECIFIC LIST

- ***North West (Glebe, Glebe Point, Forest Lodge, Annandale, part of Camperdown)***
  1. Upgrade Glebe Point Road
  2. Improve access and landscape Wentworth Park parklands
  3. Improve safety at Department of Housing estates
  4. Complete Orphan School Creek Gully link
  5. Improve footpaths
  6. Provide new and improved cycle ways
  7. Link open spaces and parks
  8. Provide new youth-oriented sporting and recreational facilities
  9. Upgrade street lighting
  10. Rationalise street signage
  11. Commence community workshops for specific projects

- ***City West (Pyrmont, Ultimo)***

1. Introduce public art and other landscaping on the Western Distributor Overpass
2. Upgrade landscaping on Harris Street, specifically around TAFE and UTS
3. Establish an education precinct linking educational institutions, the ABC and the Powerhouse Museum
4. Increase tree planting
5. Upgrade street lighting
6. Increase retail diversity along Harris Street
7. Improve traffic and pedestrian safety
8. Greater attention to preserving heritage buildings
9. Improve STA bus services

- ***Inner South (Redfern, Waterloo)***

1. Continue upgrade of Redfern and Regent Streets
2. Continue upgrade of Redfern Park
3. Reduce traffic impacts
4. Plant more trees
5. Provide planter boxes on roundabouts and traffic islands
6. Upgrade street lighting
7. Add more sustained STA bus services
8. Provide better pedestrian and cycle pathways
9. Increase dumped rubbish collections
10. Establish Redfern Street as a niche shopping precinct
11. Introduce community bus services
12. Instigate 40km/hour speed zones
13. Compile a comprehensive traffic management plan

- ***Inner East (Surry Hills, Redfern East, Strawberry Hills, Moore Park, Paddington, Centennial Park)***

1. Improve street lighting
2. Reduce the impact of 24 hour club and hotel trading
3. Reduce the noise of garbage collections
4. Increase programs to address homelessness
5. Introduce shuttle bus services to reduce car use at large events
6. Plant trees on Gilligan's island
7. Provide new signs and bins for Oatley Road Reserve
8. Increase dumped rubbish collections
9. Improve pedestrian safety near roads
10. Extend light rail
11. Increase native tree planting, especially on Dowling and Cleveland Streets
12. Divert express bus services away from local streets
13. Instigate 40km/hour speed maximum

14. Improve cycleway access to the City
15. Improve pedestrian routes to Central Railway Station
16. Use a uniform footpath surface
17. Upgrade Crown street

- ***City East (Woolloomooloo, East Sydney, Potts Point, Elizabeth Bay, Rushcutters Bay, Darlinghurst, Kings Cross)***

1. Provide more directional signage for Rex Centre
2. Reduce garbage collection noise
3. Improve enforcement of parking/alcohol/noise regulations
4. Remove abandoned cars on Victoria Street
5. Increase tree plantings on main streets
6. Reinvigorate sites like the Fitzroy Gardens and the rear of the Kings Cross police station
7. Increase interaction between Rangers and the public
8. Improve identification of 24 hour entertainment zones and reduce the impact on surrounding residents
9. Provide better pedestrian access from Woolloomooloo to the City
10. Address anti-social behaviour around Springfield Mall
11. Rationalise street signage
12. Improve monitoring of sex industry workers and managed premises
13. Address issues relating to homelessness

- ***Inner West (Chippendale, Darlinghurst, Newtown, Erskineville, Golden Grove, Macdonaldtown)***

1. Introduce branding for all areas
2. Upgrade footpath facilities
3. Increase street furniture and landscaping
4. Upgrade King Street
5. More community events to reinforce local identity
6. Control littering and illegal dumping
7. Introduce community workshops
8. Improve safety at accident hotspots
9. Begin an education campaign to reduce dog droppings
10. Provide more CCTV security cameras to discourage break and enter crime.

- ***City South (Alexandria, St Peters, Zetland, Beaconsfield, Rosebery Green Square)***

1. Provide a range of facilities in parks, including public toilets and possibly cafes. Upgrade Alexandria Park with more seating and increase secure dog areas.
2. Improve bus stop safety and access
3. Keep advocating for lower fares on the Green Square rail service
4. Consider traffic calming devices and more 50km/h speed zones

4. Improve landscaping and the appearance of the area.
5. Create pedestrian links between local parks
6. Upgrade street lighting to improve safety at night
7. Develop local retail precincts that can act as friendly neighbourhood hubs and improve linkages between these.

- ***CBD (Sydney, Haymarket, Chinatown, Millers Point, Dawes Point, Darling Harbour, Circular Quay, The Rocks)***

1. Revitalise Chinatown
2. Increase the use of laneways
3. Work with State and Federal Governments and commercial stakeholders on pro-active tourism and retail initiatives
4. Complete pedestrian networks between Broadway and UTS
5. Broaden street art programs
6. Increase “the buzz” in the City via street markets and theatre
7. Instigate a “Be Friendlier to Visitors” program
8. Extend light rail
9. Introduce more controls on illegal dumping and street posters.
