Pick-up Times

All Children must be collected from the centre 15 minutes prior to closing time.

Programs

Out of school hours programs provide care for children attending primary school (k – yr6).

The program provides a range of craft and recreational activities, computers / play station, homework support, and specialised activities.

It can cater to up to 45 children daily.

Children need to be enrolled to attend the program, access criteria apply.

Staff will make every effort to keep to the program; however, there may be a need to cancel activities at certain times.

Although many of our programs are free, there may be a fee for some activities to cover material costs and some tutor fees. Please contact staff for specific details.

We CANNOT care for children who are under school age. Any such children who come to the centre must be accompanied and supervised AT ALL TIMES by an adult. This is because we are not licensed to cater to children under school age. The centre has a number of playgroups for children aged 0 – 5 years. Please ask at reception.

Sick Children

Sick children are not permitted to attend the centre as they may spread infection. If you need us to administer medication to your child, you must complete a Medication Authority Form. Please ask staff.

Valuables

We are unable to take responsibility for or secure valuables (including toys, electronic games, bikes, scooters etc) or money children bring to the centre. Children are encouraged not to bring any such items to the centre.

Policies

A copy of our centre policies and procedures is located in the office please ask staff if you wish to read our policies.

Behaviour

All children attending the program are expected to follow the centre guidelines. This ensures that all children who attend the service are safe and enjoy their time at the centre. Staff will use various behaviour management techniques to guide children's behaviour. However, if inappropriate behaviour continues staff may contact the child's parent/carer to discuss the child's behaviour, and the child may be asked to leave the centre and return at a later date. The child's access to the service may also be restricted for a period of time. At all times staff will endeavour to work with the family to ensure the best outcomes for the child. If children's inappropriate behaviour continually places them or other children or staff at risk they may not be able to attend our service.
