- a rate-paying lessee has a documented liability to contribute to any rates due on the rateable property for at least 3 years from the
 application date.

If you own, occupy or are a ratepaying lessee by yourself as an individual use `Non-resident claim for individual owner, occupier or ratepaying lessee'.

Note: A person cannot vote more than once in any City of Sydney local government election.
