An IDAP is a plan that says how we will support people with disability to be part of things.




Inclusion means that everyone can take part in programs and services.

People with disability will help us make the plan.




City of Sydney made a **survey** to find out what we should put in the new IDAP.

- Disability Service Providers.




We will use the information we get from the survey to help make our new IDAP.


