Liquor licence temporary change of boundaries – footpaths and roads



Before you complete this form

What this form is for

It's for a licensee or the owner of an On-premises, Hotel, Club, Small Bar or Producer/Wholesaler licence who seeks approval for a temporary alfresco dining area to be included in their licence boundaries. This may include outdoor spaces such as footpaths, laneways and areas that have been closed off to traffic, if approved by Council/the Landholder.

What the temporary change of boundaries allows you to do:

It allows you to sell or supply liquor for:

- consumption on the premises as per your current liquor licence and newly approved temporary outdoor dining area
- between 10am and 10pm Sunday to Thursday and 10am and midnight Friday and Saturday, or a shorter period in line with the trading hours of your approved liquor licence, or the approved trading hours on your current development consent.

Who can submit this form:

- the existing licensee
- · current premises owner
- a legal representative or other representative on behalf of the licensee (a declaration must be completed if lodged on behalf of the licensee or premises owner) – use form 'LLMDEC01 Online liquor licence modification: declaration by licensee' at liquorandgaming.nsw.gov.au

Note - What you need to know

- Food and water must be available while the alfresco dining area is operating (existing statutory requirements);
- The approved plan must be made immediately available for inspection on the premises by a police officer, council officer or Liquor & Gaming NSW inspector.
- If your licence already permits minors to be present at the premises (whilst in the company of a responsible adult), this application will also allow minors in the new alfresco area and no further application is required.
- If your licence already has a Primary Service Authorisations, this
 will be temporarily extended to included the temporary outdoor
 dining area and no further application is required (you will still
 need to comply with the Primary Purpose Test).
- Extended trading hours authorisations do not apply to the temporary outdoor dining area.

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The following conditions are proposed for the duration of the temporary change of boundaries. Additional conditions may be imposed on a case by case basis.

Outdoor dining is allowed on a temporary basis, subject to the following:

- i. Food must be available to patrons within the outdoor dining area at all times that the area is operating.
- ii. A copy of the approved plan of the licensed boundary must be made immediately available for inspection by a police officer, council officer or Liquor & Gaming NSW inspector upon request.
- iii. Despite any other trading hours on the licence, trading hours in the alfresco dining area may not exceed 10pm Sunday to Thursday or 12am Friday and Saturday.
- iv. This temporary change to boundary may be revoked at any time by the Council/Landholder or Liquor & Gaming NSW.
- v. The licensee may sell liquor from the indoor area of the premises to patrons using the temporary outdoor dining area provided that the Licensee ensures drinks are only consumed within the licensed areas.

You can provide objections or comments on the proposed conditions and they will be considered before a decision is made.

Personal information is any information or opinion that identifies an individual, or enables someone to identify an individual. I acknowledge that L&GNSW is collecting information on behalf of Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority Board to enable processing of the application.
- I also understand that L&GNSW will use this
 information for its intended purpose only, store the
 information securely, and allow the applicant to access
 and update the information. When processing this
 application, L&GNSW may disclose information to
 other Government agencies.
